5. a. There are dark markings on the head. b. The head is all white and the feet are red.	Go to question 6 Red-Footed Booby
6. a. The entire head is dark grey. b. The head has dark and white markings.	Juvenile Albatross Go to question 7
7. a. There is a black bar through the eye and a black crown. b. There is a black mask on its face.	Sooty Tern Masked Booby
8. a. It has a hooked beak. b. It has a thin, straight beak.	Frigate Bird Go to question 9
9. a. It has a brown body and a light “cap” on its head with fuzzy edges. b. It has a very dark brown body and a white “cap” on its head.	Brown Noddy Black Noddy
