What is Summer Ag?

The purpose of the Summer Agriculture is to maintain contact with you, the student, during the summer and to provide you opportunities and guidance to work on and improve your SAE (agricultural project). <u>Time & Place:</u> 7:30 am Meet at Mountain View


